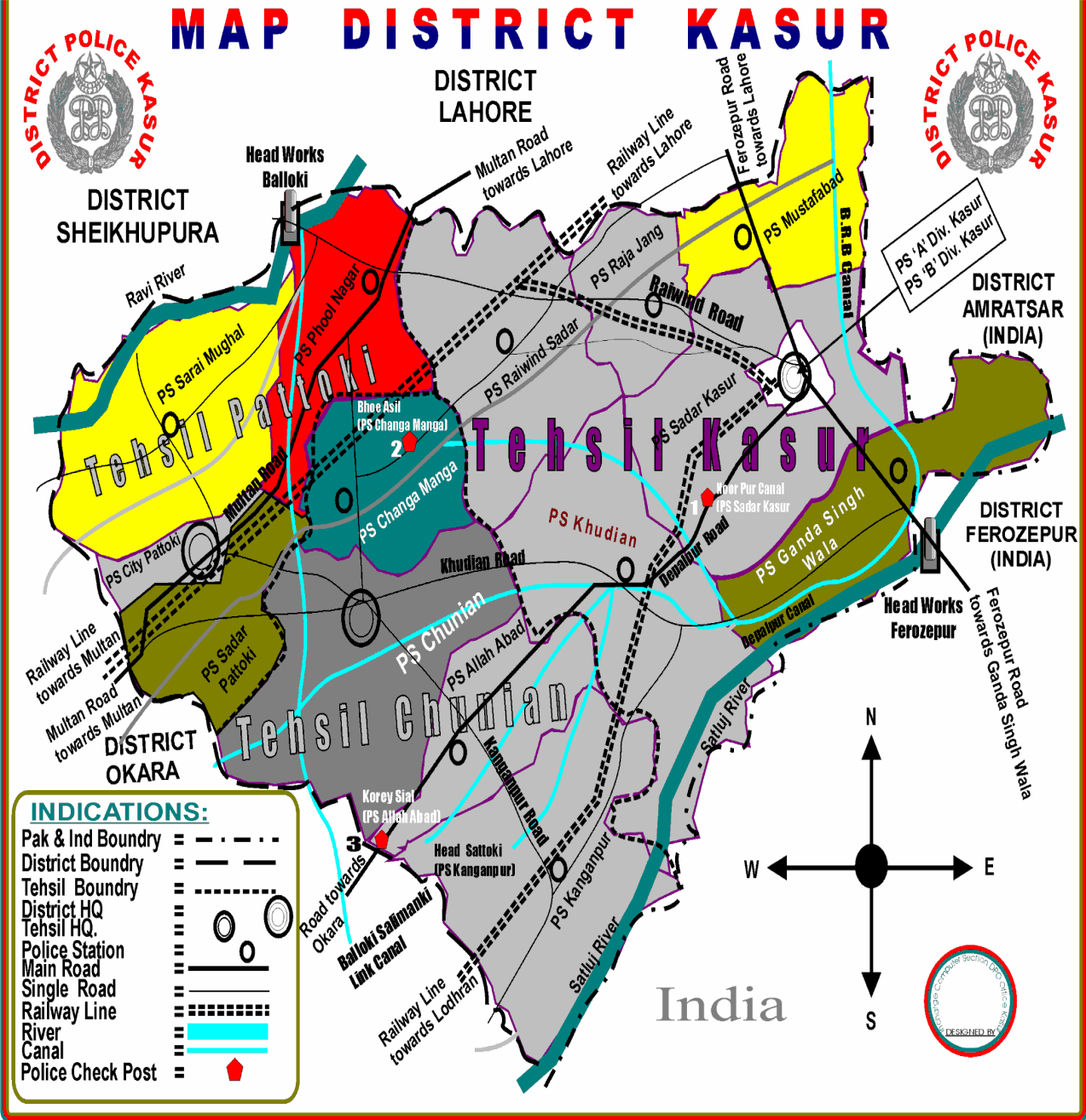

STRATEGY TO CONTROL CRIME
