



## **MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING**

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is made between:

MEDICAL SUPERINTENDENT. ALLAMA IQBAL MEDICAL COLLEGE, LAHORE, hereinafter referred to as MS.

And

THE POLICE DEPARTMENT. GOVERNMENT OF THE PUNJAB having its registered office at Central Police Office, 4-Church Road, Lahore (Here in after referred to as "The Punjab Police" Which, wherever the context so admits, shall include its successors and assignees) of the other part.

The Punjab Police and Allama Iqbal Medical College, Lahore may hereinafter be referred to individually as "party" and collectively as "the parties".

## PRINCIPAL AGREEMENT

The parties do hereby agree:

- That the Allama Iqual Medical College, Lahore is ready and willing to establish a
  dedicated Help Desk to provide medical facilities to the families of Punjab Police Shuhada
  through one window operation. This desk will be established to provide medical treatment/
  services to the families of Shuhada in a befitting manner, promptly and qualitatively.
- The Shuhada's families / patients will report at the said desk in case of any medical emergency / need. The front desk staff so deputed shall take the patient to the concerned ward / consultant and through all procedures. One-window services will be ensured through the Shuhada's Help Desk.
- 3. The MS will appoint a focal person to streamline the services, whereas, Welfare Branch, CPO will also appoint one focal person for coordination.
- 4. That the Punjab Police will submit referral / unique card for identification of entitled patients.
- 5. That The Punjab Police is grateful to avail such services.

Now, therefore, subject to the terms and conditions hereinafter so forth, the parties through this MOU do hereby mutually agree with the above said promises to pay gratitude to the families of Shuhada.
